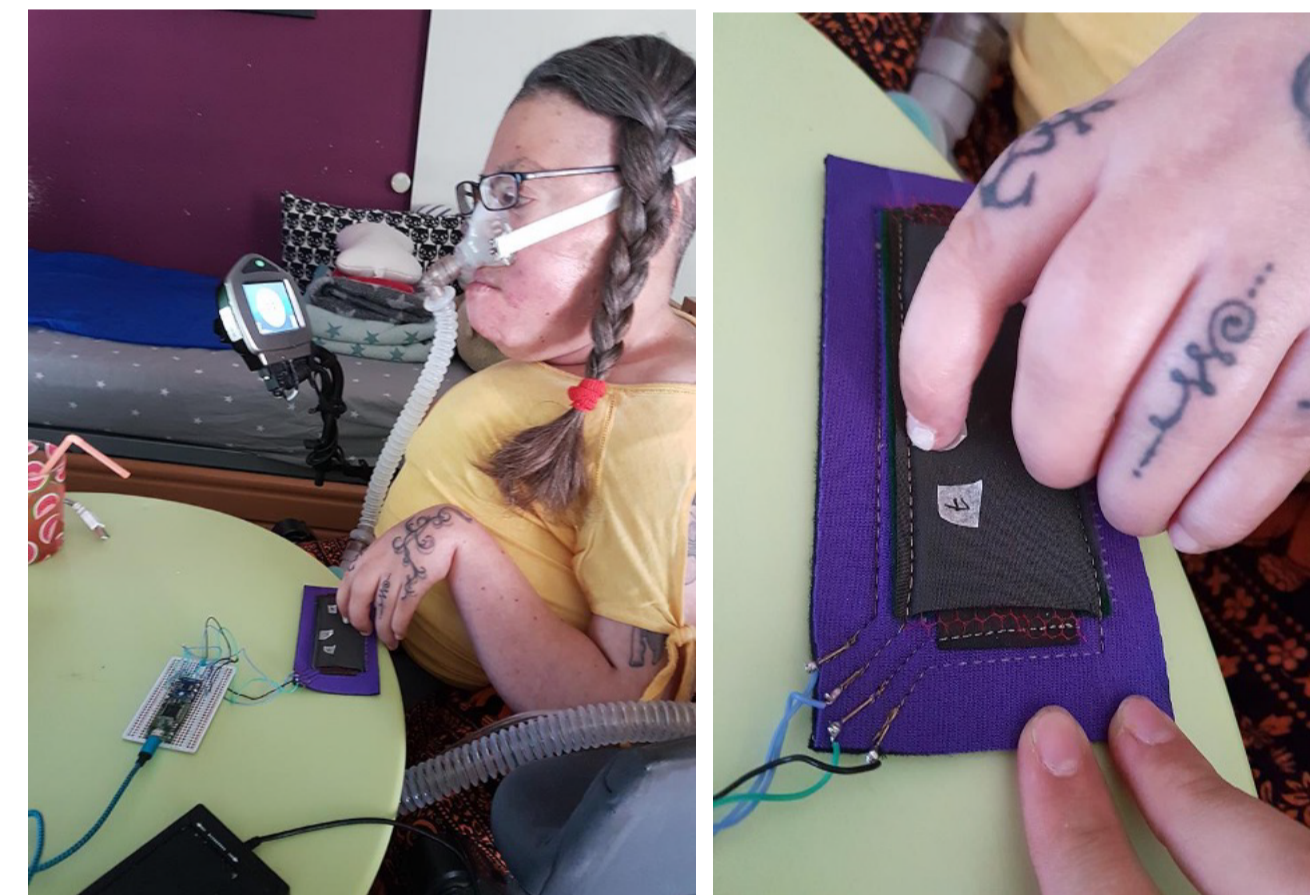

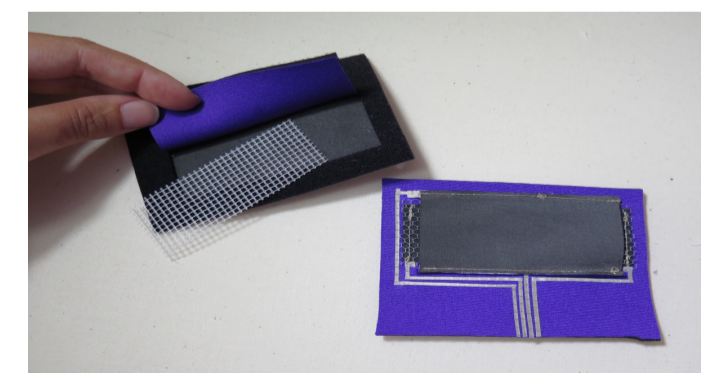


The tables illustrate an alternative to the common practice of elaborating moral or aesthetic values.

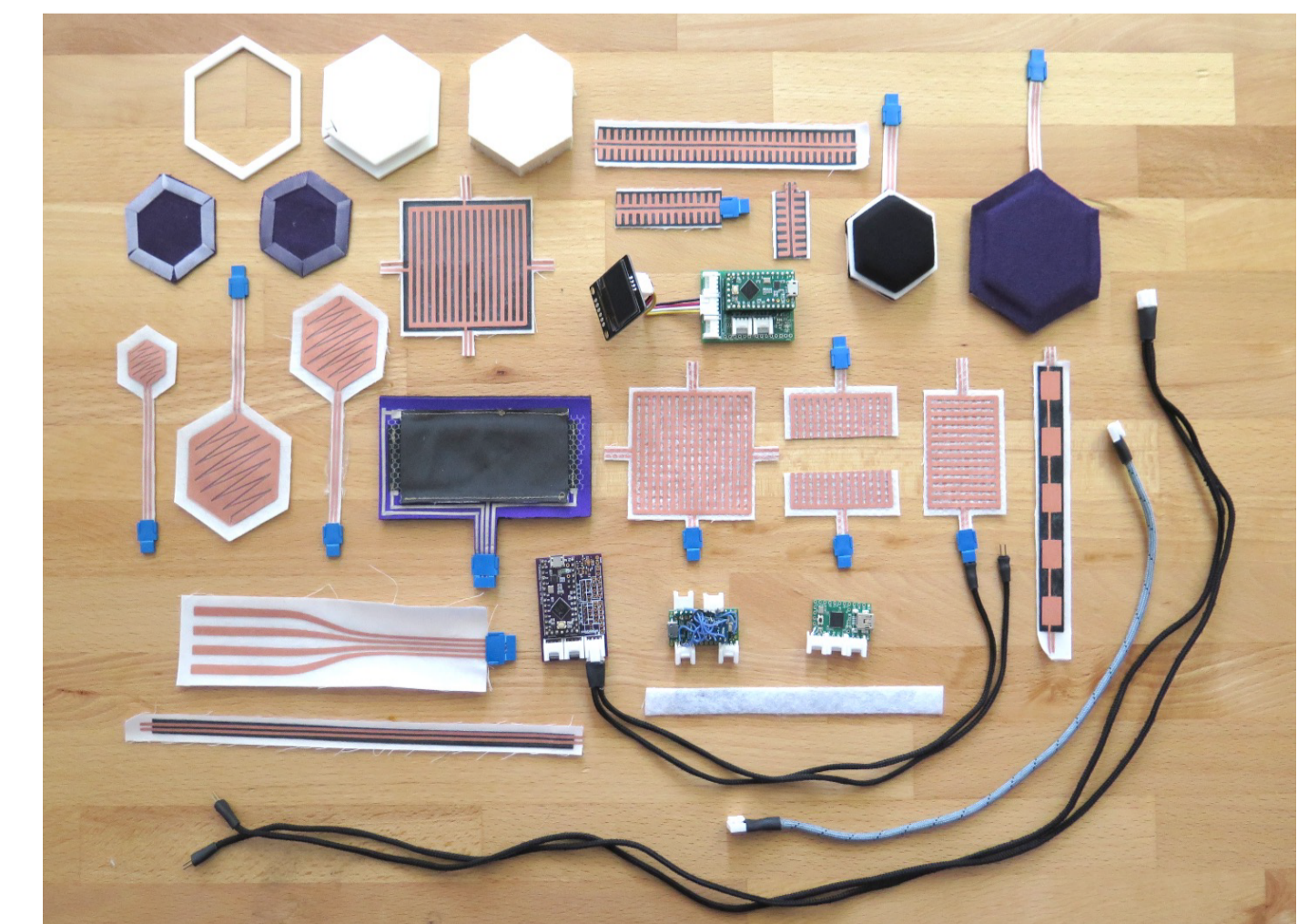


Instead we identify and celebrate different orientations of all participants and participating institutions respecting the capacity for difference to be productive and counter-productive, uniting and alienating.
